Cadet Timings are as Followed:

- 25 Feb – 0800 hrs – Green and red stars arrive at gate.
- 26 Feb – 1500hrs – All cadets picked-up from gate.

* = mandatory, must show before parents leave .If they do not have it they will be sent home! Kits are checked!

NOT PERMITTED: *FOOD, CELL PHONES, ELECTRICAL GAMES OR APPLIANCES, BIG TEDDY BEARS, MUSICAL PLAYERS, CIGARETTES, ALCOHOL, HAIR SPRAY, PERFUME, PERSONAL SLEEPING BAGS
