Cadets are permitted to wear combats. Combats must be a complete set with ranks.

The purpose of this exercise is to have the cadets learn survival skills, map and compass, leadership and to have a fun time.

A kit list is attached to this permission slip / information sheet. If a cadet does not have the proper clothing and equipment when arriving at the FTX they will be sent home.

Cadet Timings are:

21 Apr – 1845 hrs - All cadets arrive at park entrance (5265 Old Guysborough Road, Wyse Corner)

23 Apr - 1500 hrs - Parents pick up cadets at park entrance (5265 Old Guysborough Road, Wyse Corner)

Any cadet attending must be completely enrolled and have a signed permission slip passed in before the weekend.

All medications and dosages must be declared on the permission slip.

INDIVIDUAL CADET KIT LIST

Cadets are permitted to wear combats as long as they are complete (boots, jacket, tunic, green t-shirt, beret/field hat). Cadets are not permitted to mix civilian clothes with combats at any point.

All bags will be subject to kit check up on arrival. If any gear is missing the cadet will not be permitted to stay.
