

BASE TOUR PERMISSION SLIP / INFORMATION SHEET

3036 RCACC will be conducting a base tour of CFB Shearwater on 17th Feb 2020. The purpose of this exercise is to have the cadets participate in a Canadian Forces Familiarization Training Day. Activities may include visiting the following:

- TEME
- Base Supply
- Fleet Diving Unit
- 406 Helicopter Squadron
- FORCE Test Demonstration
- Organized Sports
- Open Gym

Dress for all cadets: Field Training Uniform (FTU) also referred to as 'combats' with appropriate rank slides, beret, and combat boots. If you do not have combat boots and have a similar black/brown hiking boot you may wear those OR a pair of running sneakers. **NO PARADE BOOTS!** Please also wear appropriate winter outer wear, cadet parka, toque, gloves. If you do not have them you can see supply ahead of time; we will give out what we have. Civilian winter jackets are permitted in the event the cadet cannot be fitted for a cadet parka, we kindly ask to try and avoid bright and flashy colours.

Cadets are also required to bring a backpack with the following items in it:

- Sports clothing
- Sneakers
- Water bottle

NOTE: We will be visiting secure buildings on the base and cadets will not be permitted to have personal electronic devices on them. They will be required to leave them on the bus. The cadet program does not take responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged devices. We encourage such devices to be left home.

Cadet Timings are as follows:

- 17 Feb – 0800hrs – Arrive at LHQ (cadet building) parking lot – 255 Damascas Rd
- 17 Feb – 1730 – Pickup from LHQ (cadet building) parking lot – 255 Damascas Rd

Any cadet attending must be completely enrolled and have a signed permission slip passed in no later than Jan 27th, 2020 AND must have their annual validation/detailed health questionnaires returned (if applicable). Permission slips can be emailed in or hand delivered during a cadet night. All medications required during the training period must be declared on the permission slip.

Cadets who violate policy and procedure (including but not limited to violence, harassment, discrimination, drugs, alcohol, any illegal activities) will be subject to being sent home, parents will be responsible to pick up their cadet immediately. They may also be prohibited from taking part in any future trips, lose training and membership privileges, if injured under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs medical insurance may not apply and any resulting expenses could be the responsibility of the guardian. Discipline will be administered as per CATO 15-22.
